Back examination: - Swelling site, size and shape - CSF leak - Transillumination test			
Sphincteric examination: - Anal examination - Distended bladder			
Lower limb examination: - Motor power (spontaneous movement, movement in response to pain) - Foot deformity			
Head examination: - Bulging fontanel - OFC			
Proper summarization of the positive finding and reaching the diagnosis
